



ILEAC/Lexipol Program

ILEAC and Lexipol have partnered to help Indiana agencies meet and maintain accreditation.

Lexipol offers a comprehensive suite of services that includes policy manual content consistent with ILEAC accreditation requirements, updates to policies and proactive policy training for staff.

Program Benefits

The Lexipol-ILEAC partnership provides:

- Policies that meet the ILEAC accreditation standards
- Updates issued to policies as needed in response to new legislation, case law or changes in ILEAC standards
- Reduced out-of-pocket expense for agencies to achieve and maintain accreditation (\$500 per year is paid by Lexipol to cover ILEAC annual accreditation fees) as long agencies are Lexipol subscribers
- Reporting tools to assist with the accreditation assessment process
- Discounted Lexipol subscription rate for agencies with fewer than 50 full-time sworn officers

Lexipol subscriptions provide:

- Custom policy content specific to Indiana
 - ✓ Comprehensive, defensible policies written by legal and public safety professionals
 - ✓ Access to more than 150 policies based on federal and state statutes, case law and best practices
 - ✓ Policy updates issued as a result of Lexipol's monitoring and review of government legislation and case decisions
- Daily Training Bulletins to ensure staff understanding and compliance with policies
 - ✓ Ties policy to real-world applications through 5-minute scenario-based training
 - ✓ Emphasis on high-risk, low-frequency events that link directly to policies
- Web-based platform
 - ✓ Manage policy content, edit content and document changes
 - ✓ Customize policy content to fit the agency's specific needs
 - ✓ Track and monitor acknowledgment of policies and documentation of completed training
- Mobile app that provides access to policy and training on phones and tablets

Application Process

- All agencies in Indiana that choose to apply for accreditation and subscribe to Lexipol will complete the [ILEAC/Lexipol application](#) and submit it directly to ILEAC along with the \$500 application fee.
- Lexipol will also notify ILEAC of new agencies that subscribe to Lexipol and indicate they will be seeking accreditation.
- ILEAC will notify Lexipol of new agencies that apply to ILEAC and indicate they will be subscribing to Lexipol.

Accreditation Fees to ILEAC

- Lexipol will pay the \$500 annual fee to ILEAC for each Indiana agency subscribing to Lexipol's program and applying for or maintaining accreditation.
- The \$500 fee paid by Lexipol to ILEAC covers the annual accreditation fees for that agency. Non-Lexipol agencies have a separate fee schedule and should contact ILEAC for information.
- Payments from Lexipol to ILEAC for all qualifying agencies are made on the anniversary date of the agreement (July 1 of each year).
- ILEAC will notify Lexipol of agencies that discontinue the process or choose not to pursue accreditation. Lexipol will also notify ILEAC of any agency that cancels their Lexipol policy manual subscription. For either of these situations, payments to ILEAC for that agency will discontinue at that time.
